Adopting askew lines and unusual angles, the playful distortions of architectural elements in the watercolor cityscapes of Zhu Hong convey a distinctive and contemporary flavor. His use of Chinese calligraphic brushwork also lends a refreshing perspective to the traditional Western painting medium.
